Alpha Mu Tau Fraternity (AMTF) and the American Society for Clinical Laboratory Science Education and Research Fund, Inc (ASCLS E & R Fund, Inc.) are pleased to announce the scholarships available this year.

**Alpha Mu Tau Fraternity** is a national laboratory fraternity whose purpose is the advancement of professionals in the clinical laboratory sciences. One of the prime activities of the fraternity is the granting of graduate and undergraduate scholarships.

- **AMTF Graduate Scholarship** is awarded to a deserving student in an approved master's or doctoral program.
- **AMTF Undergraduate Memorial Scholarship** of up to \$3000 is awarded to the highest-scoring applicant.
- **AMTF Undergraduate Scholarship**. Several Scholarships up to \$2000 are awarded to deserving students in NAACLS-accredited programs in clinical laboratory science.
- **Ruth M. French Memorial Scholarship Fund** was established in 1987 by friends of Ruth French and AMTF to honor her contributions to the profession. Ruth was a noted author, authority, and consultant in allied health accreditation.
- **Dorothy Morrison Memorial Scholarship Fund** was established in 1985 in memory of an outstanding member of our fraternity and is funded by donations from friends and members.
- **Ida & May Reilly Memorial Scholarship Fund** was established in 2000 in memory of Ida Reilly and her sister May. Ida was a member of the fraternity, a Clinical Laboratory Science Educator, and a very active CLS Professional.
- **Martha Winstead Memorial Scholarship Fund** was established in 2002, in memory of Martha, a member of the fraternity, and a past president of the American Society of Clinical Laboratory Science. Martha was very active in the profession.
- **Royce Watson Scholarship Fund** was established in 2008 by Royce Watson, a member of AMTF since 1971.
- **James Holley Memorial Scholarship Fund** was established in September 2011 by the Holley Family and friends. "Jim" was "Mr. ASCLS" for over 50 years; Past President, Chair of almost every national, regional, and state committee.
- **Eleanor Parchman Memorial Scholarship Fund** was established in 2013 by her two sons. Eleanor was very active in every phase of our Society for many years. To many, she was "simply" Ms. Credentials.
- **John P. Smith Scholarship Fund** was established in 2022 by John P. Smith, a former president of ASCLS and longtime member of ASCLS and AMTF.

## **ASCLS Education & Research Fund, Inc. Scholarships:**

- **Edward C. Dolbey Trust Scholarships** were added in 2012. Each undergraduate Dolbey scholarship winner is awarded *up to* \$2,500 for **MLS**, *up to* \$2,000 for **MLT**, and *up to* \$3000 for a **graduate** Dolbey scholarship winner.
- **Bernadette "Bunny" Rodak Memorial Scholarship** was established in memory of a key member of ASCLS. Bunny was an amazing advocate, leader, and educator.
- **ASCLS Past Presidents' Scholarship** will be awarded to a **graduate student** in a master's or doctoral program.
- **SnyderWomen Scholarship** will be awarded to an **MLT matriculating to MLS**.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS:**

- **All applicants must be ASCLS members.**
- Additional Scholarship **GUIDELINES** are listed on the Scholarship Application form.
- Only **one** application is needed for all of the Graduate scholarship options.
  - Graduate applicants cannot complete their education before September 1st.
- Only **one** application is needed for all of the Undergraduate scholarships options.
  - Undergraduate applicants (MLS or MLT) must be entering the final year of their **NAACLS-accredited program**.
